Next steps

- A task group will now look at all priority projects and check that all criteria have been met satisfactorily
- As soon as the task group is happy this is the case, an offer letter will be issued by LCC
- If there are any outstanding issues, a member of the task group will be in contact with the project proposers to check how these issues can be addressed.
- If issues remain outstanding and cannot be resolved, the funds will be awarded to the reserve project instead (subject to the criteria being satisfied etc.)
- The task group will also work with Reserve Project Proposers to look at options & solutions to try and get as many of these projects delivered.
